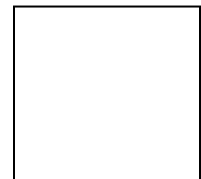

Beansie knows how much she loves her garden. Her vegetables and flowers are her pride and joy. He hangs his head down in shame. Her garden is now in ruins and he knows that she is going to be upset. He feels terrible. Mrs. Jones walks over to him and Beansie knows he is in trouble. Then the funniest thing happens. She bends down and hugs him hard. **(paragraph 4)**

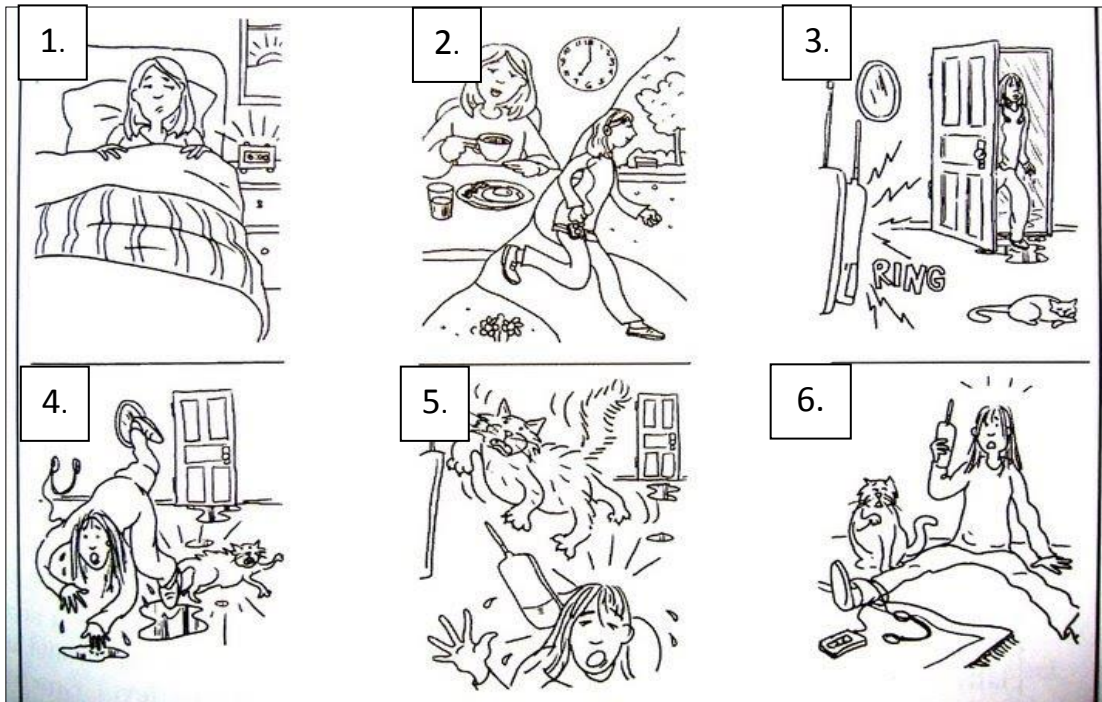
