

## MAKING FRIENDS - BRINGING FRIENDS CLUB

Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Migrant Learners' Unit, in collaboration with the Foundation for Educational Services (FES), is holding a **Making Friends – Bringing Friends** after school club. The aim of the club is for participants to have an opportunity to speak and interact while participating in informal, enjoyable creative sessions. A snack will be served at the beginning of each session. The snack, which will vary each time, will represent a typical item of food from different nations/ethnic groups and will help participants to become aware of the variety of traditions related to food.

Learners who are attending school **from Year 3 to Year 6** can apply. **Participation is free of charge**, but the number of participants for this club will be limited.

Club sessions will be held **once weekly (or twice during certain weeks) and there will be a total of 10 consecutive sessions held between May and June 2019**. The club will be held at the **Maria Regina College Naxxar Primary School from 14:30 – 17:00 in May and 12:00 – 14:30 in June**. Further details on the exact dates will be communicated at a later stage.



Parents are being requested to note the following:

- Parents will be expected to pick up their children immediately at the end of each session. If the parent does not pick up the child on time, he/she will incur charges;
- Children who are participating in the club's activities cannot leave the club before the end of the session;
- If a child does not attend 3 consecutive sessions, his registration in the club will be terminated;
- **Transport will be provided, free of charge, for the participants after the sessions to go back home if needed.**

The Migrant Learners' Unit reserves the right to amend, cancel or shift sessions according to the number of applications and availability of staff. Should you wish for your child to take part in this club, kindly fill in the details below and return this form to the school by not later than **Tuesday 16th April 2019**.
