Next scholastic year your daughter/son will be attending **Year 3**. Below is a list of things you will need. Please make sure that all objects are in your child's bag on the first day of school. Thanks.

1 A4 project book labelled Maths Investigations , covered in brown paper and plastic
1 narrow lined copybook – 48 pages – covered in blue, labelled English
1 narrow lined copybook – 48 pages – covered in red, labelled Malti
2 wide lined copybooks – 48 pages - both covered in green, labelled Maths
4 extra copybooks – 2 wide lined and 2 narrow lined
1 narrow lined copybook, - 48 pages - covered in blue, labelled Creative Writing
1 narrow lined copybook, - 48 pages - covered in red, labelled Kitba Kreattiva
1 narrow lined copybook, - 48 pages – covered in yellow, labelled Word Race
1 wide lined copybook, - 48 pages - covered in fancy paper and plastic, labelled My Journal
1 wide lined copybook, - 48 pages - covered in purple, labelled Book Review
1 blank copybook (no lines), covered in fancy paper and plastic, labelled PSCD
1 blank copybook (no lines), covered in green, labelled Maths Challenge Cards
1 A5 green button folder, labelled Maths Challenge Cards
1 Display file – 40 pages – labelled Publishing
1 lever arch file with 4 dividers – 1 red (Malti), 1 blue (English), 1 green (Maths), 1 any colour (Extra)
1 A4 transparent button folder, labelled Science
Mini whiteboard, whiteboard marker and eraser
2 A4 transparent buttoned plastic folders for handouts, both labelled with child's name
1 box file as a homework folder, around 3cm wide, labelled with child's name
1 A3 plain drawing book and 1 plastic A3 button file for drawing book
Scissors – rounded edge, 2 large glue sticks, 2 pencils, rubber, sharpener
3 highlighter (pink, yellow and green)
Pencil or crayon colours, individually labelled
Apron/T-shirt to be used during Art lessons
Maths Toolbox (shoebox covered in wrapping paper) to include to following items:
Laminated number grid with child's name (attached please find the number grid)
Glue the die sheet provided on a cardboard and make a die
60 bottle caps in 3 different colours
30 straws in 3 different colours (10 each colour)
Whole set of real Euro coins
Clock face (attached) – stick numbers, laminate and attach hands with a split pin
3 ten frames (attached)
3 sets of paperclips (12 in each chain)
1 deck of playing cards (including A, J, Q, K)

Children must have the following items in their school bag every day:

All items should be labelled with the student's name and surname, class and subject. Details should be written in a pen and in block (not cursive).
