Subject: 'Read at Home' Scheme 2021

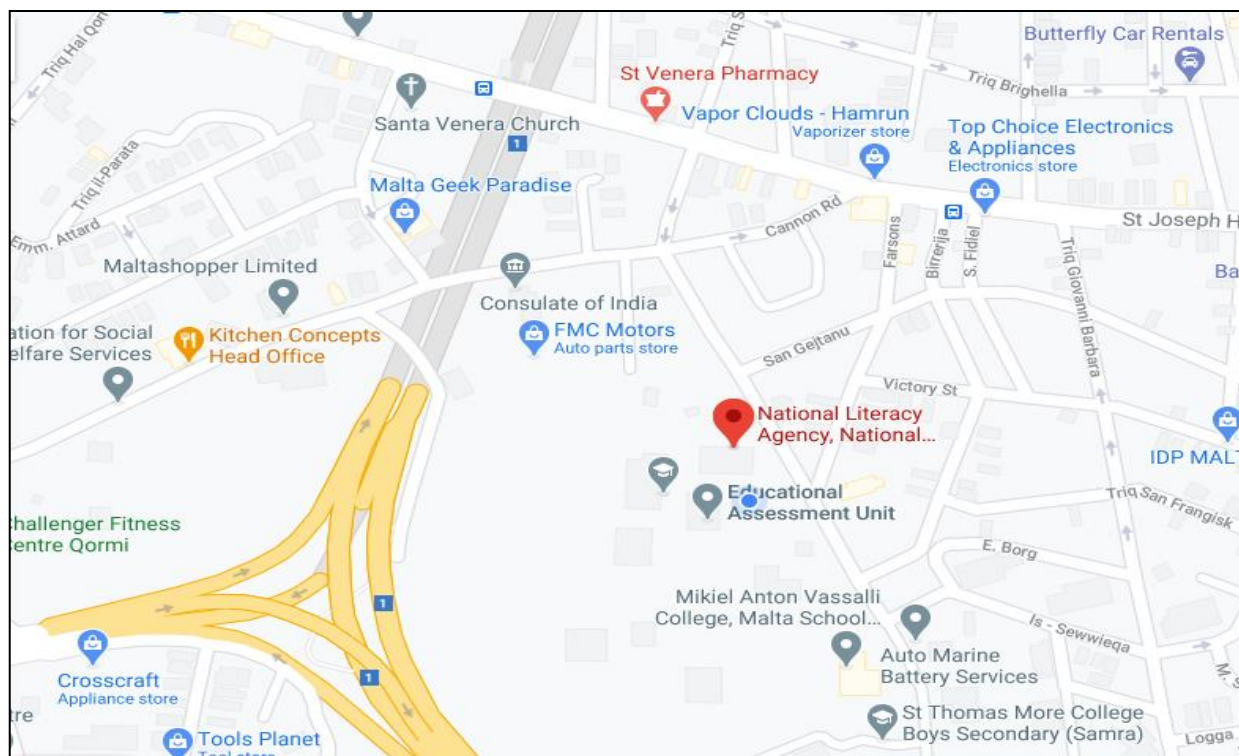

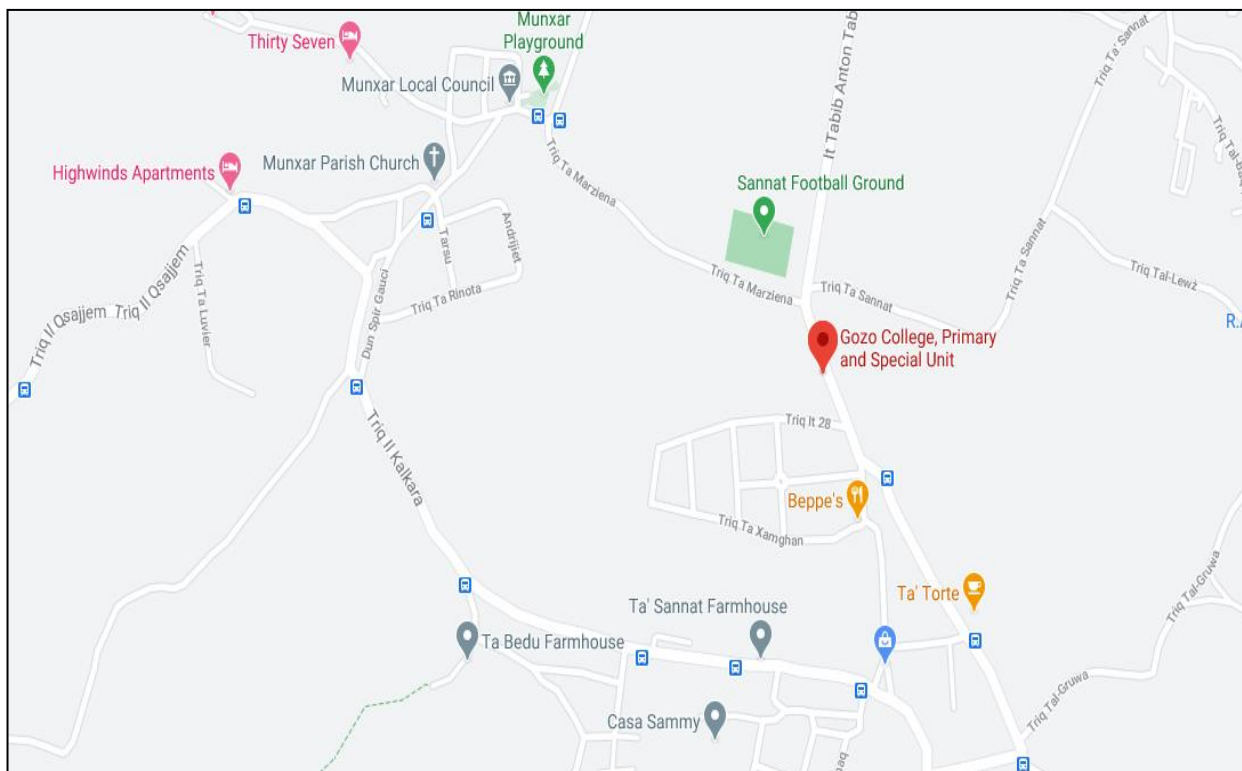

Books will be posted or delivered free of charge in an appropriate envelope. Books can be kept up to a maximum of 5 weeks and are to be returned to one of our Book Return Boxes in the same envelope that they were received in. In Malta, the Book Return Box is located outside the National Literacy Agency Building on Joseph Abela Scolaro Street, Hamrun, HMR 1304.





In Gozo, the Book Return Box is situated outside the Literacy Resource Centre Gozo College, Sannat Primary School and Special Unit, Ta' Sannat, Sannat Road, Sannat, SNT 9020.
