Ideas for Show and Tell

- Pets (pictures, soft toy or something belonging to their pet) can be good subjects for Show and Tell.
- If a child learns about certain **animals at the animal park/bird park/petting farm**, s/he may take **photos** to show to his class.
- Something as simple as a favourite book can make a good subject.
- A favourite toy can be used in a Show and Tell session.
- A present/ card given by a special member of the family or friend can be a good idea.
- A child's artwork may be shared during Show and Tell.
- A model/something the child worked on at home maybe during Christmas, the crib, during Carnival – a carnival float/mask/ puppet etc.
- Many children enjoy sharing a particular holiday abroad or family outing memories.
- A child may want to speak about a family member/s or friend/s and show a photo or some photos.
- Step by step photos/video of an activity s/he has done at home (which will serve as prompts). Examples may include, building blocks, doing jigsaw puzzles, a science experiment, painting a picture, mixing ingredients while cooking.
- A child may decide to speak about his **favourite hobby** sports, martial arts, camping, scouts, music etc.
