

## **School Uniform, Accessories and Casual Clothing**

**Aim of the Policy** - This policy outlines guidelines regarding proper School Uniform, Accessories and Casual clothing.

### **Summer Uniform Items:**

- The College shorts with appropriate length;
- The College polo shirt/t-shirt with short sleeves;
- Black socks with black plain Velcro trainers. Trainers may also be mainly black.
- White socks with white plain Velcro trainers. Trainers may also be mainly white.
- Trainers with laces are not recommended for KG students.
- The College cap or any plain white cap.

### **Winter Uniform Items:**

- The College tracksuit;
- The College polo shirt/t-shirt with long sleeves;
- The College jacket with the College logo;
- The polo neck beneath the school polo shirt/t-shirt must be either white, dark blue or black;
- Beanies, scarves and gloves must be in dark blue or black;
- Black socks with black plain Velcro trainers. Trainers may also be mainly black.
- White socks with white plain Velcro trainers. Trainers may also be mainly white.
- Trainers with laces are not recommended for KG students;
- Wellies, preferably in a dark colour.

### **Outings:**

Students must wear their full uniform.

### **Dress Code for Birthdays and Casual Days:**

- Students may come in casual clothes on their birthdays.

- School-appropriate attire is important. Below are a few examples of clothing that **will not** be accepted: short skirts, booty shorts, crop tops, spaghetti-strap tops, see-through clothes.
- Wanzies are to be avoided due to toileting.
- Earrings should be studs.

**Accessories for Normal School Days include:**

- Earrings: stud only;
- Hair accessories: dainty, colour of the school uniform (navy blue, green, black);
- Hair needs to be neatly tied;
- Nail polish is not allowed;
- No jewellery such as expensive necklaces, bracelets or rings are allowed;
- No bulky jewellery is allowed;
- No smartwatches are allowed;
- No make up and tattoo stickers are allowed.

If students do not abide by the school uniform policy, the S.L.T. phones the parents.

Uniforms, caps included, must be labelled with the child's name and surname.
