Dear parents/legal guardians,

We would like to inform you that in the upcoming scholastic year, your child will be entering Year 1. Kindly find below a list of items required for the new school year. We ask that all listed items be placed in your child's school bag and brought on the first day of school. It is important that all pencils and crayons are in one pencil case which is easy for the child to open and close.

	2 red line - narrow lined copybooks – 48 pages – covered in red, labelled Malti 1 and Malti 2
	1 red line - narrow lined copybook - 48 pages – covered in red, labelled Malti CW
	2 red line - narrow lined copybooks – 48 pages – all covered in blue, labelled English 1 and English 2
	1 extra copybook – 48 pages – red line - narrow lined
	1 blank copybook – covered in fancy wrapping paper, labelled My Journal
	1 A5 green envelope file -labelled Maths Challenge Cards
	1 blank (no lines) copybook covered in green, labelled Maths Challenge Cards
	1 thick colouring book
	1 watercolour palette set
	1 flat paintbrush (no. 8)
	Apron/old shirt
	2 A4 plain drawing books and 1 A4 transparent plastic button folder where drawing book should be inserted
	2 HB pencils, eraser, 15cm ruler and a sharpener, ALL CLEARLY LABELLED
	4 A4 plastic button envelope folders – any colour- one labelled "Homework" , one labelled "Library Books" , one labelled "Handouts" and the other labelled "Spelling Books"
	1 A4 button folder (any colour) labelled "Music"
	Labelled crayons in pencil case (IMP: no pencil colours)
	4 large glue sticks and 1 rounded small scissors
	2 big cardboards (any colour) and 5 A4 cardboards (any colour)
	2 whiteboard markers & 1 eraser, ALL CLEARLY LABELLED
	1 small whiteboard (A4 size)
	1 set of lower case magnetic letters

The following items should be in the school bag every day: tissues, wipes and a fabric napkin for lunch.

All items should be labelled with the student's name and surname.

Please make sure that children come to school with 2 SHARPENED pencils every day.

If a pencil is too short, it should be replaced.

Please ensure that the following items are included in your child's school bag each day: tissues, wipes, napkin. All items must be clearly labelled with the student's full name, class, and subject where applicable. Kindly ensure that your child comes to school each day with two **sharpened** pencils. If a pencil becomes too short for practical use, we kindly ask that it be replaced promptly.

Whenever possible, we kindly ask that you reuse folders and supplies from the previous academic year, in an effort to promote environmental awareness and sustainability. Thank you for your cooperation.

Additional note:

We strongly believe that helping your kids with the skills below during the summer period will help them thrive next scholastic year:

scissoring skills

a good tripod grip

knowing how to write their name

being able to put on the school jacket and closing its zipper

wearing their school bag

opening and closing one's bag and pencil case

opening and closing one's lunch box and water bottle

recognising the numbers, shapes and possibly the Maltese letters.
